## The Khoi Liberation Movement Strategic Plan; 43 Point Plan

The Khoi Liberation Movement being grounded in Pan Africanism and scientific Socialism seeks the following

- Develop Pan Africanism as a central ideological framework locally and within the continent and disapora
- 2. Develop Socialism as the economic system of Africa based on natural ubuntu or indigenous humanity
- 3. Work towards in united and just Africa where the people are the state and not corporations or families or individuals
- 4. Popularise the principle of participatory democracy and locate power within the hands of the people
- 5. Popularize the concept of people power and its functionality in the new Africa
- 6. Popularize the concept of one African people from Cape to Cairo this across tribe, or nation states or ethnicities

## To that end it will

- 1. Form linkages with other revolutionary Pan African groups that are like minded
- 2. It will create events that highlight African leaders and the histories of Africa from Cape to Cairo and in the Diaspora
- 3. Ot will look at indigenous land rights and solutions that lead to peace and just settlements
- 4. It will seek to change the school curriculum to include indigenous histories, languages, Pan Africanism as an African concept and solution
- 5. It will work towards applied Socialism on the ground through economic development and people owning the means of production and Africa trading across borders
- 6. It will seek to create public events that that bring African heroes to the fore and places Pan Africanism and Africa in the psyche of the people themselves
- 7. It will seek reparations from the colonial powers as a highlight of Africa and its will to powerand redress
- 8. It will seek to address African issues within the context of Pan Africanism and one people across the colonial divides and this without borders
- 9. It will fight the concept of Xenophobia that is built around narrow nationalism, ethnicities and artificial colonial borders
- 10. It will fight elitism and corruption that stops the continent from uniting along the lines of peace, stability and security
- 11. It will enhance the concepts of democracy, equality and justice based on Pan Africanist values of one humanity, anti racism, anti Capitalism and anti-discrimination
- 12. Fight against religious discrimination and the use of religion to promote regime change and the destabilization of sovereign nations

- 13. It will fight the militarization of global society and the control by the Military Industrial Complex
- 14. It will fight against torture and disappearances by government and the repression of the peoples voices and rights
- 15. It will fight for the freedom of expression and the freedom of the press and media as a whole
- 16. Form networks and collaborate with all Pan African and indigenous groupings that share common goals
- 17. Create Federations or collectives that can drive the indigenous and Pan African agenda
- 18. Engage the AU and PAP to actualize the Peoples Agenda
- 19. Form tribunals that are people centered and hold all accountable and equal before the law bith locally and internationally
- 20. Support any claims of reparations by Africans and indigenous people against colonialism and Capital
- 21. Monitor and create profiles of anti-people governments or neo colonial states, design interventions and act accordingly
- 22. Lobby and agitate for an African Criminal Court of Justice
- 23. Create investigative units to monitor human rights abuses, indigenous rights abuses, corruption and plunder of lands and resources by corporations and governments
- 24. To track and trace the theft and exploitation of indigenous knowledge by multi-national companies like Phizer or other pharmaceutical companies
- 25. Investigate companies that have profited from colonialism and seek reparations from them
- 26. Profile countries that have captured the economies of African countries and educate, agitate and militate against them
- 27. Agitate for the removal of AFRICOM from African soil
- 28. Agitate against the land grabs by colonial and Capitalist entities through corporate buy outs and the capture of governments
- 29. Agitate and militate against companies that seek to introduce GMO's into Africa and endure that legislation is enacted that criminalized exploitation and the ;patenting of food sources
- 30. To agitate for governments and entities like the AU through Pan African Parliament to enact legislation for governments or heads of state or politicians to be indicted for treason where deemed fit or necessary
- 31. Develop track and trace and repatriation mechanism to bring back the stolen wealth to Africa and ensure accountability by the political structures and state looters
- 32. To lobby against immunity by some countries to errant politicians who loot and use those countries as a refuge base
- 33. To lobby the ICC to be equal in treatment of governments and move from racially determined indictments and look at countries like America and NATO which have violated international law and engage d in extra judicial killings and regime countries
- 34. Look to the criminalization of the FBI and CIA in international circles
- 35. To look at joint investigation units for Crimes Against Peace and crimes against Africa
- 36. To lobby for legislation that compels bankers like the Swiss and other bankers to be also indicted in cases of fraud or state looting or exploitation around the world in general and Africa in particular

- 37. Lobby for legislation for Bankers to be accountable and liable in the criminal and civil contexts if they profit from exploitation or environmental damage
- 38. Lobby for African diamonds that are processed and polished in England to be declared, and legally treated as, "Blood Diamonds"
- 39. Lobby for restorative justice from colonial and Capitalist countries including the Queens and Kings or Capital that has profited from colonialism and exploitation
- 40. Reclaim all artifacts that have been stolen and kept in private and government collections and such private collectors indicted and brought before a court of law in the very locations where the crimes occurred; the crimes committed by Europeans should be tried in Africa by Africans if the exploitation or crimes were committed in Africa or Iraq or Syria or Palestine or West Papua
- 41. Criminalize Anti-Africanism just as Anti-Semitism is criminalized globally
- 42. To criminalize racism and the proceeds deemed "blood money" or in the case of shares "blood shares"
- 43. Fight Zionism as another form is racism

This is the larger picture and strategy that may span twenty years or even more but sets the ground work for those yet to come.

There are finer details that have been omitted as they are confidential and do not belong in the public domain but will be shared if and when we enter into MOUs or ACCIRDS with fellow activists or organization.

## What have we started thus far

- 1. We have issued a proclamation to the British Crown, the African Union, The AU, PAP and will follow up with legal letters and action when we have finalized the legalities of the action
- 2. We have approached the Pan African Parliament around issues like representation
- 3. We have created a Pan African Parliament Mobilization group on FB
- 4. We have registered holding companies to trade commodities within Africa and the Diaspora
- 5. We are beginning to raise awareness of African fashion and the textile industry and add glamour to the African image to be internalized by Africans as well as place the industry in their hands through an All African Beuty and Fashion Symposium to be held annually
- 6. We have registered and begun a training company that has a Pan African view of the marketplace
- 7. We have registered a media company that looks at medias across the spectrum from print to animation to film to software
- 8. We are looking at linking African Funders in the Diaspora with products and companies in African through centralized investment and centralized distribution that are safe secure and productive
- 9. We are currently designing small and medium businesses that are turnkey operations with minimal risk to funders and bring in good returns
