Some Strategies of the All-African People's Revolutionary Party (A-APRP) 30 December 2017

- **I. Build ideologically strong revolutionary organization** by organizing Pan-African political education circles that will train organizers to join and help organize revolutionary Pan-African political parties. One of the primary areas of focus is university campuses to stress the importance of students as a spark, as well as other sectors of the African world where we stress the need for a revolutionary intelligentsia. A revolutionary African intelligentsia is needed to help provide the in depth analysis that will aid the masses in organizing. Understanding that for this phase of the revolution, Pan-Africanism can only be achieved by organizing the Masses, one fundamental aspect of our strategy is **constant political education**, (political, ideological, cultural, and technical).
- II. Bring African Organizations together Build and work with African united fronts in the diaspora, Africanist movements based in Africa such as the Worldwide Pan-African movement (WWPAM), and Nkrumah's vision of an All African Committee for Political Coordination (AACPC). Establish coordination among revolutionary and progressive Parties of Africa where they do not exist and intensify them where they already exist, (called the All-African Committee for Political Coordination A-ACPC by Kwame Nkrumah), linked with the World-Wide Pan-African Movement (WWPAM). At the level of the Central Committees of the African revolutionary Parties, (called the All-African Committee for Political Coordination A-ACPC by Kwame Nkrumah), our strategy is to link with the Organization of Solidarity with the People of Africa, Asia and Latin America (OSPAAAL) the revolutionary and anti-imperialist progressive Parties and anti-zionist movement of the world.
- III. An offensive to strike out at the enemy on three fronts 1) expose and smash the FBI/CIA and all imperialist intelligence networks and the Industrial police/military complex; 2) expose and smash Zionism; 3) Expose and crush bourgeois political parties in imperialist countries that pose as the friend of Africans for example; Labour party in UK, Democratic party in USA, Socialist party in France.
- **IV. Fight patriarchy and gender inequality** We recognize we must engage in class/nation/gender analysis. The rights and work of women must be recognized and developed to further the struggle for Pan-Africanism and socialism.
- **V. Work to institutionalize African Liberation Day** as a process that coordinates political education, activism and organization around Pan-Africanism in Africa and the Diaspora.

- **VI. Call for Positive Action** On the road toward total liberation in Africa we need positive action from the masses. They are the true makers of history. The All-African People's Revolutionary Party has for more than 15 years called for movement on the following positive actions:
- 1. The land reclamation process initiated in Zimbabwe must be expanded to address the return of land in all of Africa. Agricultural land reform will bring about the conditions where Africa can feed Africans. This land reclamation process must be expanded to address the theft of Africa's mineral resources. The profits from the extraction of minerals from Africa must be used for Africa's development. The colonial occupation of Africa in the 19th and 20th centuries resulted in the theft of the best land. This land must be returned to the rightful owners, the poor and the landless Africans.
- 2. Africa's debt to the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and the World Bank must be cancelled and the IMF and World Bank dismantled. These institutions have only served to disrupt the development of Africa, playing a significant role in creating this debt. In light of the crimes committed against African people and the theft of Africa's resources, we claim the cancellation of this bogus debt as a down payment on reparations due Africa and African people.
- 3. All Africans, whether born in Africa or outside of Africa and wherever they live in Africa or outside of Africa, must be viewed as citizens of Africa and should be allowed to live and travel anywhere in Africa. The elimination of the boundaries established by colonialism is a prerequisite toward the building of true Pan-Africanism (an Africa under one union government where people contribute based on their ability and receive based on their contribution)
- 4. All foreign military bases on African soil must be closed immediately and mercenary forces disbanded. We are against imperialist military bases in Africa and the World. An Africa-wide peacekeeping force must be established to end all internal conflict in Africa and focus on the security of women and children.
